

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2023, Town Moderator Rick Zamore notified the Selectboard that he made two mistakes in moderating the Town of Guilford 2023 Town Meeting held on March 7, 2023;

WHEREAS, Moderator Zamore did not properly respond to: 1) an Objection to Consideration relative to Article Five; and 2) a request to Divide the Question during the discussion of the General Fund;

WHEREAS, the mistakes were inadvertent and were not the result of an unlawful notice or warning or noncompliance with the scope of the warning;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 17 V.S.A. § 2662, errors or omissions in the conduct of an original meeting that are not the result of an unlawful notice or warning or noncompliance with the scope of the warning may be cured by a resolution of the legislative body of the municipality by a vote of two-thirds of all its members at a regular meeting, stating that the defect was the result of oversight, inadvertence, or mistake;

WHEREAS, the Selectboard desires to cure the mistakes made by Moderator Zamore through this resolution by a vote of two-thirds of its members pursuant to 17 V.S.A. § 2662;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the errors or omissions in the conduct of the Town of Guilford 2023 Town meeting were the result of mistake and were not the result of an unlawful notice or warning or noncompliance with the scope of the warning; and




